### 1 Log in

Follow the steps to log in to the Multi User Service device.

Note that some steps in this manual are only relevant for certain models and you can skip chapters. You can see this by the note in the chapter heading "Only for ". You can see where you can jump to in the blue frame.

#### 1.1 Connect to the Internet

Connect to the Internet to log in to the machine. To connect the machine to a new Wi-Fi network, follow these steps:

Tap the icon at the top right.



Tap and hold the Wi-Fi icon.

- Select an available WLAN and connect the device to it.
- Tap the "*Back*" button until the login screen appears.

- Enter your DB User login details (DB User login name and DB User password).
- Tap on "*Log in*".

Hint:

- If the screen with the message "*Profile not found*" or "*The existing profile has been removed*" is displayed, this is either because the permissions are missing or the data is still loading.
- Wait until the apps are installed or alternatively tap "Sync and reload" to speed up the loading process.
